- Baltic between Kentucky and M.L.K.
- New York between Baltic and Mediterranean
- Drexel between New York and So. Carolina
- Adriatic between M.L.K. and New York
- Ocean between Drexel and Caspian
- Tennessee between Caspian and Adriatic
- New York from Magellan to McKinley
- M.L.K. from Grant to Marmora (also includes the entire M.L.K./Marmora intersection).
