Criteria:

All students:

- Must have a grade point average of 2.75 or higher.
- Must be majoring in a field related to the hospitality, culinary or tourism industry and currently enrolled.
- All paperwork must be one-sided.
- Students must be currently enrolled and attending the Summer 2024 or Fall 2024 semester at Atlantic Cape Community College, Stockton University or Fairleigh Dickinson University-AC and be able to show enrollment.

Full Time Student

- Must be currently enrolled as an undergraduate at Stockton University or Fairleigh Dickinson University-AC program and have earned 20 credits at the time of application.
- Must be currently enrolled as an undergraduate at Atlantic Cape Community College and have earned 12 credits at the time of application.
- Must maintain a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours per semester.

Part Time/Non-Traditional Student

- Must be enrolled in SU. FDU-AC. or ACCC.
- Must have earned 6 credits at the time of application.
- Must be enrolled with a minimum of 3 credits per semester.
